

SAFETY AREA REMINDERS

- At dismissal we ask drivers not to park on the Lahmeyer side. If you want to park and walk to the safety area to pick up your children, you can do so from the State Boulevard side.
- At arrival drivers should pull all the way forward when dropping off their child, especially on the Lahmeyer side.
- All students should enter and exit vehicles from the passenger side.
- Students who cross the street at dismissal are expected to be on their best behavior. They should go directly to their pick-up location and should not be running or horse-playing.
