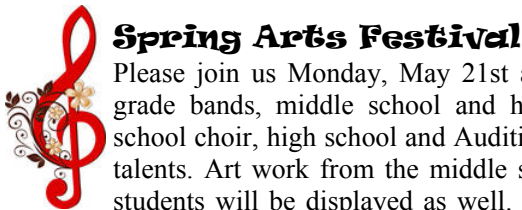

2012 KICKBALL TOURNAMENT IS UNDER WAY

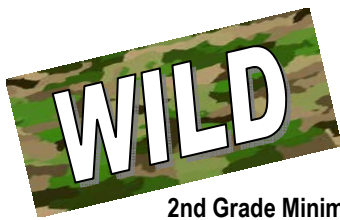
